Ranney Memorial Scholarship

The Stickney, Thwing, Ranney and Darrow families made these scholarships possible.

The Ranney Memorial Scholarship consists of two \$2000 grants for first-year college students.*

Eligibility:

1. The Applicant must be a Windham County Resident.
2. High school seniors will be given first consideration.
3. Attendance in a two or four year program in agriculture or allied field such as forestry, natural resource management, conservation, horticulture or outdoor recreation, etc.
4. The Application MUST be complete.

Applications:

1. Applications should be sent to the Windham County Farm Bureau, c/o Carlene Hellus, 42 Hemlock Hill Drive, Dummerston, VT 05301
2. The Deadline is April 1, 2020

Selection:

The selection committee is made up of members of the Windham County Farm Bureau Board of Trustees. Selection will be made on the basis of financial need, character, motivation and scholastic ability and may include an interview with the selection committee. The selection committee and president will recommend applicants to the full board for approval.

Presentation:

If possible, the scholarship will be awarded in person at an Awards Assembly or at a Farm Bureau meeting, by an officer of the Farm Bureau

Disbursement:

The scholarship will be paid directly to the student in two equal payments. The First half will be presented to the student at the time the scholarship is awarded. The Second half will be mailed upon receipt of the first semester transcripts. The recipient must attain a GPA of 2.0 or better for the first semester.

*If there are no qualified high school applicants, the scholarship may be awarded to a Windham County student who is already enrolled in an agricultural curriculum at an accredited college.
